Dear Members and Guests of The Children's Play Gallery,

We are excited to welcome you back for interactive play at The Children's Play Gallery beginning **Monday, August 3rd**. Due to the current situation, we will need to run things a little differently for the time being.

****There is IMPORTANT information below. Please make sure to read through all of it.****

If you have a Membership or 15 Visit Pass, the expiration date has been extended by 5 months. We were closed for 4 1/2 months and we appreciate your support as we transition into these new procedures.

We are going to have set blocks of times for playing with a set capacity of 50 people. (This number includes children and adults) See Reservation information below.

Play times will be:

Monday - Friday
9 AM to 12 Noon OR 1 PM to 4 PM
Museum is CLOSED from 12 Noon to 1 PM*

Saturday
10 AM to 12:30 PM OR 1:30 PM to 4 PM
Museum is CLOSED from 12:30 to 1:30 PM*

Cost is \$11.50 per child one year of age and older. No charge for adults. The admission fee covers the time period reserved. (M-F 3 hrs. or Sat 2 1/2 hrs.)

*During the hour that we are closed between shifts, we will be cleaning and disinfecting as much as we can.

At the end of the day, our regular cleaning routine of all the toys getting sanitized, bathrooms cleaned, floors mopped, carpets vacuumed, etc. will take place.

Please note there are two waivers, a COVID-19 and the original Liability, that you need to read and mark off the box that you consent to these when making your reservation on the website.

As with going anywhere right now, you go at your own risk. We will be dedicated to providing a clean and inviting environment, but there will always be germs around us.

Please follow the general guidelines, if you or any of your children are not feeling well, please stay home.

Temperatures will be checked before anyone can enter the museum. Temperature needs to be 100.4 degrees or lower to enter.

Adults and children over 9 years of age need to wear a mask. **You need to bring your own mask.** If children 3-8 years of age have masks, that is great, but we know it can be challenging to expect them to keep a mask on.

Please do not plan on having meals at The Children's Play Gallery. The eating area will be available for a quick snack. We do expect adults to wipe down their children's area when they are finished with snacks. Disinfecting supplies will be provided in the eating area.

For the time being, water bottles, coffee, etc. will need to be kept in a set spot, above the coat hooks or in a locker.

The Art and Science Areas have latched gates. These gates should remain latched with the exception of going in and out. Adults are expected to attend these areas with their children.

We ask for your cooperation during this time...We will try to make an announcement 10 minutes before each closing time, so you can start preparing your kids for leaving. Staff needs the time to make the museum clean and welcoming for the next group of visitors.

Again, we look forward to seeing you and working together to make this a wonderful experience for everyone.
